### Thursday, April 30th- Tech Rehearsal Expectations

1. Please arrive 5 min prior to your designated call time (Kaufman Front st. Entrance)
  2. Costumes/Hair/Makeup are not required. Please wear your dance shoes and rehearsal attire.
  3. Dancers will be housed in the auditorium. Please use the restrooms in the Lobby.
  4. Snacks are allowed ONLY in the Lobby. Dancers under 10 yrs must have an adult present in the lobby.
  5. Parents/Adults are **required** to sit (in audience) with dancers under the age of 8 yrs old
  6. NO entering/sitting on the balcony, or in the hallways/cafeteria for parents/adults & dancers

### Dress Rehearsal - Friday, May 1st - Kaufman Auditorium (Cafeteria Entrance)

**5:30 pm- All Dancers Arrive** in full costume, makeup, and hair

**5:45 pm-** Rehearsal of Bows and group picture

**6:00 pm- Start at top of show** (Dismissed in Cafeteria after one run on stage)

**8:00 pm All Remaining Dancers Dismissed**

### Friday, May 1st- Dress Rehearsal Day Expectations

1. Dancers will be housed in the Cafeteria for Dress Rehearsal.
  2. Dancers in Act II are welcome to watch Act I in the Auditorium, sitting together as a group.
  3. Dancers in Act I may get their photo taken after their routine. Dancers in Act II get their photo taken during Act I.
  4. Young dancer parents/adults are welcome to stay in the Auditorium, but not required.
  5. Snacks are allowed ONLY in the cafeteria.
  6. Please check out with your backstage volunteer before leaving the cafeteria at pickup time.
  7. Costumes are to be left in the Cafeteria in designated locations.
  8. No changing in Cafeteria or Hallway (there are cameras).

### Saturday, May 2nd- Performance Day Expectations

- **Intermission:** Parents/Families are **NOT** to visit dancers backstage during intermission - no exceptions
- **Snacks and Drinks:** Nut free snacks ONLY. No drinks or food that will stain costumes.
- **Activities for Backstage:** Bring a quiet game or activity to do backstage. **NO** tablets/phones, markers or paint, toys that make loud noises, valuable toys or things.

#### **Drop Off:**

- Do NOT arrive early.. you will be locked out
- Parents/adults are welcome to assist your dancer, to get dressed into costumes at drop off time.
- No changing in Cafeteria or Hallway (there are cameras).
- Then say goodbye unless you are a signed up backstage volunteer.
- Please walk around outside, to the Auditorium Entrance, if you are watching the show.

#### **Pick Up:**

- Your dancer will be brought back into the **cafeteria for pickup** after the show! (The show is about 1.5 hrs long)
- Please check out with your backstage volunteer before leaving the cafeteria at pickup time.
- Costumes are to be left in the Cafeteria between shows, in designated locations.
